The Heritage Club, Department of History, KLE Law college, invites applications from Under-Graduation/ Post graduation /researcher scholars for award of Small Research Grant programme to pursue research in frontier/advanced areas of cultural heritage including Ethnography, tourism, Tribal Studies, Archaeological sites disputes, Illicit trafficking of antiquities, and Heritage protections laws for a period 3 months.

A total of 15 applications received from across India were reviewed and interviewed by a panel of experts.

Based on research proposal, experience, subject knowledge, defining of their proposal, academic merit and publication record, 4 candidates were recommended (Annexure I) for the award of Small Research Grant programme (HC-SRGP) 2023 (June to August). The awardees will be informed via mail regarding the guidelines in order to complete administrative formalities to avail this award.

The awardees are requested to stay in touch with their host institutes (through email/phone/virtual platforms) and may start to work on the prerequisites needed for their project.
